RADIO STATIONS TO BROADCAST APTN INDIGENOUS DAY LIVE THROUGHOUT NORTH AMERICA

June 11, 2019, Winnipeg, Man. - Indigenous radio stations will broadcast concerts from the 13th annual APTN Indigenous Day Live on **June 22, 2019**. Communities across Canada and the U.S. can join in the largest celebration of Canada's National Indigenous Peoples Day in a variety of ways.

This year, people will be gathering in [Winnipeg](#), [Calgary](#) and [Whitehorse](#) as well as around their TVs and radios.
